## **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2013**

As Recommended by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

## **Brief\***

HB 2013 is a technical bill that would delete from the definition of perjury a reference to a provision removed from the statutes by 1999 Session Laws Ch. 22, Sec. 2. The provision removed in 1999 required a new employee to sign a statement under penalty of perjury concerning whether the person was currently or had been ordered to pay child support pursuant to a court order.

## **Background**

In the House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice, a representative of the Judicial Council appeared in support of HB 2013. The Judicial Council requested introduction of the bill. There was no other testimony.

The House Committee requested the bill be placed on the consent calendar.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates passage of HB 2013 would have no fiscal effect.
