SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2034

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Judiciary

Brief*

Senate Sub. for HB 2034 would repeal statutes that allowed the Department of Corrections to purchase real estate in 1986.

Background

HB 2034, as amended by the House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice, would have amended provisions concerning search warrants, including language specific to search warrants for tracking devices. The Senate Committee on Judiciary added the contents of that bill to HB 2017.

After the Senate Committee on Ways and Means struck the contents of HB 2143 and replaced them with the contents of its appropriations bill, the Senate Committee on Judiciary agreed to strike the contents of HB 2034 and replace them with HB 2143, as introduced.

HB 2143 was introduced by the Committee on General Government Budget. The Department of Corrections testified in support of the bill. There were no opponents to the bill.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget states the bill would have no fiscal effect.
