## **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2138**

# As Amended by House Committee on Utilities and Telecommunications

#### **Brief\***

HB 2138 would repeal seventeen statutes concerning oil and gas.

# **Background**

The bill was introduced by the House General Government Budget Committee. The Kansas Corporation Committee (KCC) had suggested the repeal of these statutes. A representative from the KCC testified at the House Utilities and Telecommunications Committee hearing on the bill that the statutes are duplicative or obsolete.

A technical amendment was made by the House Committee to include a statute for repeal inadvertently omitted from the bill.

The fiscal note submitted by the Division of the Budget on the original bill indicated the bill would have no fiscal effect.
