SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2142

As Amended by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

Brief*

HB 2142 would repeal certain obsolete statutes regarding unified school district land transfers and higher education loan and grant programs.

Background

There was no testimony on HB 2142 in the House Education Budget Committee, and the Committee recommended the bill be placed on the consent calendar due to the noncontroversial nature of the bill.

The bill was amended by the Senate Ways and Means Committee to include the contents of HB 2149 that would repeal certain obsolete statutes regarding higher education loan and grant programs. There was no testimony on the bill.

The Board of Regents provided written testimony on HB 2149 listing the statutes to be repealed and the reasons why the laws are no longer needed. There was no other testimony. The House Education Budget Committee recommended the bill be placed on the consent calendar.

The Division of the Budget fiscal notes on the original bills stated enactment of HB 2142 and HB 2149 would have no fiscal effect.
