HB 2167 would designate the first Wednesday of February 2014 and the first Wednesday in February of each year thereafter as "Native American Legislative Day at the Capitol."

Background

Representative Ponka-We Victors sponsored the bill and spoke as a proponent for the bill. Spokespersons from the Prairie Band Potawatomie Nation and Kickapoo Tribe also spoke in support of the bill. There was no opponent testimony.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget states the passage of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
