## **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2353**

As Recommended by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

## **Brief\***

HB 2353 would add a synthetic cannabinoid, commonly known as UR-144, to the list of schedule I controlled substances.

## **Background**

In the House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice, representatives of the Kansas Bureau of Investigation and the Kansas Board of Pharmacy appeared in support of the bill. No others offered testimony.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates passage of the bill would have no impact.
