## MINUTES OF THE SENATE FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Senator Lana Oleen at 10:45a.m. on April 26, 2000 in Room 245-N of the Capitol.

Chairman Oleen ask members of the committee to review several bills that had been passed out of Federal and State Affairs and the full Senate but would not receive consideration on the House floor. **SB 652–new born protection act** has had hearing in the House Federal and State Affairs, but will not be brought up on the House floor. Senator Oleen stated that **HB 2838-disposition of earnings of child actors** had passed the house 122 to 0 and had had hearings in this committee. She recommended that **SB 652** be amended into **HB 2838** and be allowed to go to conference committee. Senator Gooch moved to amend SB 652 into HB 2838. Senator Harrington seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Becker moved to report HB 2838 favorably to the full Senate as amended. Senator Vratil seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Chairman Oleen noted that there were other bills which had had hearings in the committee and passed the Senate, but would not be afforded consideration on the House Floor. These were the bills introduced by the Joint Committee of State Tribal Relations, **SB 543–powers to Native American Indian law enforcement officers and SB 607–interlocal agreements with Native American Tribes.** It was also noted that **SB 492–Racing and Gaming Commission** as passed by the Senate should be included.

Senator Oleen stated that **HB 2540** is in the Federal and State Affairs Committee and would be ameanable to these bills. After discussion by the committee Senator Gooch moved to delete all provisions in HB 2540 and place SB 543, SB 607 and SB 492 into it. Senator Biggs seconded the motion. The motion passed. Senator Becker moved to report HB 2540 favorably to the full Senate. Senator Harrington seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Chairman Oleen noted that she had five pages in attendance today; Judy Lim, Stacy Wulfkuhle, Amanda Steffens and Heather Martin from Junction City Middle School; and Andee Lee from the Susan B. Anthony Middle School.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m. The next meeting will be on call of the Chairman.
