**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2252 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2252 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2252 would create the new “Armed Services Occupation Medal” distinctive license plate. A person could be issued the new plate by submitting proof that the recipient has been awarded the Army of Occupation Medal or the Navy Occupation Service Medal. The plate would not be subject to the personalized plate fee. The bill would allow the plate to transfer to a surviving spouse or other family member if there is no spouse.
