SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2624 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2624 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2624 would limit members of the Kansas Legislature to receiving no more than 90 days of per diem compensation and subsistence allowances during a regular session of the Legislature.

According to Legislative Administrative Services, enactment of HB 2624 would have no fiscal effect unless a regular session would be longer than 90 days. The budget for the Legislature assumes a 90-day Session when the budget is prepared. With enactment of HB 2624, if a regular session of the Legislature would be longer than 90 days, per diem compensation and subsistence would be capped at 90 days. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2426 is not reflected in *The FY 2017 Governor's Budget Report*.
