**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2736 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2736 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, motor carriers, trucks, and truck tractors registered with the Kansas Corporation Commission are granted exemption from the requirement to stop for clearance inspection if the vehicles fulfill stated requirements. However, HB 2736 would clarify that the Kansas Highway Patrol is not prohibited from stopping any motor carrier, truck, or truck tractor upon probable cause to believe that a spot check is necessary.

According to the Kansas Highway Patrol, there would be no fiscal effect resulting from the enactment of HB 2736.
