## HOUSE BILL No. 2033

## AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning overtaking and passing; speed limits.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
Section 1. (a) A driver of a passenger car, motorcycle or truck, not towing any other vehicle or trailer, may exceed the speed limit by up to 10 miles per hour while passing another vehicle traveling at less than the legal maximum speed, in order to safely pass the vehicle pursuant to K.S.A. 81516 or $8-1518$, and amendments thereto. The overtaking vehicle shall return to the right-hand lane and reduce speed to the posted speed limit as soon as practicable. This subsection shall be applicable only upon roadways divided into two lanes for two-way movement of traffic and where the posted speed limit is 50 miles per hour or greater. This subsection shall not be applicable in construction zones. Passing a vehicle pursuant to this subsection shall be subject to all other applicable motor vehicle laws. A driver of a vehicle exceeding the 10 miles per hour limitation of this subsection shall be subject to the full penalty or penalties applicable to exceeding the posted speed limit by the actual speed of the vehicle.
(b) This section shall part of and supplemental to the uniform act regulating traffic on highways.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
