1	AN ACT concerning water; relating to multi-year flex accounts; amending
2	K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 82a-708c and repealing the existing section.
3	
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
5	Section 1. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 82a-708c is hereby amended to read as
6	follows: 82a-708c. (a) A term permit is a permit to appropriate water for a
7	limited specified period of time in excess of six months. At the end of the
8	specified time, or any authorized extension approved by the chief engineer,
9	the permit shall be automatically dismissed, and any priority it may have
10	had shall be forfeited. No water right shall be perfected pursuant to a term
11	permit.
12	(b) Each application for a term permit to appropriate water shall be
13	made on a form prescribed by the chief engineer and shall be accompanied
14	by an application fee fixed by this section for the appropriate category of
15	acre feet in accordance with the following:
16	Acre Feet Fee
17	0 to 100\$200
18	101 to 320\$300
19	More than 320\$300 + \$20
20	for each additional 100
21	acre feet or any part thereof
22	On and after July 1, 2018, the application fee shall be set forth in the
23	schedule below:
24	Acre Feet Fee
25	0 to 100\$100
26	101 to 320\$100
27	More than 320\$150 + \$10
28	for each additional 100
29	acre feet or any part thereof
30	The chief engineer shall render a decision on such term permit
31	applications within 150 days of receiving a complete application except
32	when the application cannot be processed due to the standards established
33	in K.A.R. 5-3-4c. Upon failure to render a decision within 180 days of
34	receipt of a complete application, the application fee is subject to refund
35	upon request.
36	(c) Each application for a term permit to appropriate water for

1 storage, except applications for permits for domestic use, shall be accompanied by an application fee fixed by this section for the appropriate 2 category of storage-acre feet in accordance with the following: 3 Storage-Acre Feet 4 Fee 5 0 to 250......\$200 More than 250.....\$200 + \$20 6 7 for each additional 250 8 acre feet or any part thereof On and after July 1, 2018, the application fee shall be set forth in the 9 10 schedule below: Storage-Acre Feet 11 Fee 0 to 250......\$100 12 More than 250.....\$100 + \$1013 for each additional 250 14 15 acre feet or any part thereof The chief engineer shall render a decision on such term permit 16 applications within 150 days of receiving a complete application except 17 18 when the application cannot be processed due to the standards established 19 in K.A.R. 5-3-4c. Upon failure to render a decision within 180 days of 20 receipt of a complete application, the application fee is subject to refund 21 upon request. 22 (d) Each application for a term permit pursuant to K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 23 82a-736, and amendments thereto, shall be accompanied by an application 24 fee established by rules and regulations adopted by the chief engineer in an amount not to exceed \$400 for the five-year period covered by the permit. 25 26 (e) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 82a-714, and 27 amendments thereto, the applicant is not required to file a notice of completion of diversion works nor pay a field inspection fee. The chief 28 engineer shall not conduct a field inspection of the diversion works 29 30 required by statute for purposes of certification nor issue a certificate of 31 appropriation for a term permit. 32 (f) A request to extend the term of a term permit in accordance with 33 the rules and regulations adopted by the chief engineer shall be 34 accompanied by the same filing fee applicable to other requests for 35 extensions of time as set forth in K.S.A. 82a-714, and amendments thereto. (g) An application to change the place of use, point of diversion, use 36 made of water, or any combination thereof, pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-708b, 37 38 and amendments thereto, shall not be approved for a term permit, except the chief engineer may approve a change in place of use for a term permit 39 approved pursuant to K.S.A. 82a-736, and amendments thereto, for 40 irrigation use may be approved by the chief engineer for: 41 An increase of up to 10 acres or 10% of the authorized place of 42 (1)use whichever is less: or 43

1 (2) an increase that is greater than 10 acres or 10% of the authorized 2 place of use, whichever is less, if such change is approved to coincide with 3 an approval of a change in place of use under the base water right. In any 4 application to change the place of use under a base water right, the 5 applicant may simultaneously change the place of use of a multi-year flex 6 account term permit to coincide with the change in place of use of the base 7 water right. There shall be no separate fee for such change.

- 8 (h) The chief engineer shall adopt rules and regulations to effectuate 9 and administer the provisions of this section.
- 10 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 82a-708c is hereby repealed.
- 11 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 12 publication in the statute book.
