## HOUSE BILL No. 2584

AN ACT concerning the veterans benefit lottery game; disposition of net 2 profits; establishing the veterans benefit lottery game fund and the national guard benefit lottery game fund; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 4 74-8724 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 New Section 1. (a) All net profits received from the sale of veterans 8 benefit lottery game tickets, materials and games, as prescribed by rules 9 and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 74-8724(b), and 10 amendments thereto, shall be transferred to and credited to the veterans 11 benefit lottery game fund and the national guard benefit lottery game fund 12 in accordance with this section.

13 (b) On or before the fifth day of each month, the executive director of the Kansas lottery shall determine and certify to the director of accounts 14 15 and reports the aggregate amount of net profits received from the sale of 16 veterans benefit game lottery tickets, materials and games, as prescribed 17 by rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 74-18 8724(b), and amendments thereto, that was transferred from the lottery 19 operating fund to the state gaming revenues fund during the preceding 20 month pursuant to K.S.A. 74-8711(d), and amendments thereto. Upon 21 receipt of each such certification, the director of accounts and reports shall 22 transfer the amount equal to 60% of the amount certified from the state 23 gaming revenues fund to the veterans benefit lottery game fund established 24 by section 2, and amendments thereto, and shall transfer the amount equal 25 to 40% of the amount certified from the state gaming revenues fund to the 26 national guard benefit lottery game fund established by section 3, and 27 amendments thereto. At the same time as such certification is transmitted 28 to the director of accounts and reports, the executive director of the Kansas 29 lottery shall transmit a copy of such certification to the director of the 30 budget and the director of legislative research.

31 New Sec. 2. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the 32 veterans benefit lottery game fund which shall be administered by the 33 Kansas commission on veterans affairs. All expenditures from the veterans 34 benefit lottery game fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation 35 acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant 36 to vouchers approved by the Kansas commission on veterans affairs or the

1 designee of the commission.

2 (b) Moneys credited to the veterans benefit lottery game fund shall 3 not be transferred to the state general fund. Moneys credited to the 4 veterans benefit lottery game fund shall be used only for the following 5 purposes:

6 (1) Fifty percent of the moneys transferred to the veterans benefit 7 lottery game fund shall be used for operating expenditures and capital 8 improvements, or as otherwise provided by appropriation acts, for the use 9 and benefit of the Kansas veterans' home, the Kansas soldiers' home and 10 the state veterans cemetery system; and

(2) fifty percent of the moneys transferred to the veterans benefit
 lottery game fund shall be used for a veterans enhanced service delivery
 program.

(c) On or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month, the director of accounts
and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the veterans benefit
lottery game fund interest earnings based on:

17 (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the veterans benefit18 lottery game fund for the preceding month; and

(2) the net earnings rate of the pooled money investment portfolio forthe preceding month.

New Sec. 3. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the national guard benefit lottery game fund which shall be administered by the adjutant general. All expenditures from the national guard benefit lottery game fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the adjutant general or the designee of the adjutant general.

28 (b) Moneys credited to the national guard benefit lottery game fund 29 shall not be transferred to the state general fund. Moneys credited to the national guard benefit lottery game fund shall be used only for purposes 30 31 directly benefiting members of the Kansas army and air national guard and 32 their families to provide for Kansas national guard educational assistance 33 act scholarships pursuant to K.S.A. 74-32,145 et seq., and amendments 34 thereto, and, to the extent that moneys are available, for other purposes 35 directly benefiting members of the Kansas army and air national guard and 36 their families

37 (c) On or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month, the director of accounts
and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the national guard
benefit lottery game fund interest earnings based on:

40 (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the national guard benefit41 lottery game fund for the preceding month; and

42 (2) the net earnings rate of the pooled money investment portfolio for43 the preceding month.

5 6 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 74-8724 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-8724. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Kansas lottery commission shall establish an instant lottery scratch-off game designated as the veterans benefit game, which shall be conducted by the Kansas lottery. Tickets for the veterans benefit game established by this section shall be offered for sale year-round.

7 (b) The Kansas lottery commission shall adopt rules and regulations 8 governing the establishment of the veterans benefit game pursuant to 9 K.S.A. 74-8710, and amendments thereto, except that subsection (b) of 10 K.S.A. 74-8710(*b*), and amendments thereto, shall not apply to the 11 veterans benefit game established by this section.

12 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 79-4801 et seq., and K.S.A. 74-8711, and amendments thereto, all net profits, received from the 13 sale of veterans benefit game lottery tickets, materials and games, as 14 prescribed by rules and regulations adopted pursuant to subsection (b)-of 15 16 this section, shall be deposited in the state treasury and shall be used as follows: (1) An amount equal to 40% of such net profits shall be-17 18 appropriated for purposes directly benefitting members of the Kansas army 19 and air national guard and their families to provide for Kansas nationalguard educational assistance act scholarships pursuant to K.S.A. 74-32,145 20 21 et seq., and amendments thereto, and, to the extent that moneys are-22 available, for other purposes directly benefitting members of the Kansas 23 army and air national guard and their families as provided by appropriation 24 act:

(2) an amount equal to 30% of such net profits shall be appropriated
 for operating expenditures and capital improvements, or as otherwise provided by appropriation act, for the use and benefit of the Kansas veterans' home, the Kansas soldiers' home and the state veterans cemetery
 system; and

30 (3) an amount equal to 30% of such net profits from: (A) July 1,-2008, to June 30, 2010, shall be appropriated for the museum of the 31 32 Kansas national guard to expand the museum facility to include a 35th-33 Infantry Division Museum and a museum education center as provided by 34 appropriation act; and (B) from and after July 1, 2010, shall be-35 appropriated for a veterans enhanced service delivery program transferred 36 to and credited to the veterans benefit lottery game fund and the national 37 guard benefit lottery game fund pursuant to section 1, and amendments 38 thereto

(d) The Kansas lottery commission shall change the design or theme of the veterans benefit game regularly so that the game remains competitive with the other instant lottery scratch-off games offered by such commission. The tickets for the instant lottery game authorized by this section shall clearly *and prominently* state *on the front of such tickets* 

- 1 that the profits derived from the game shall be used to benefit veterans and
- 2 veterans issues in this state.
- 3 Sec. 5. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 74-8724 is hereby repealed.
- 4 Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 5 publication in the statute book.
