AN ACT concerning Kansas government; relating to boards, commissions, councils, authorities and other governmental entities; creating committees to study shared resources, labor capacities and mission alignment.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) There is hereby created the general industry regulatory committee, the public health and welfare regulatory committee and the financial industry regulatory committee. The purpose of these committees is to study strategic shared resources, consolidated leadership and budgetary oversight of the entities listed subsections (f), (g) and (h). The committees shall examine the strategic missions of each entity listed in such subsections and shall determine where potential alignment may occur.

- (b) The committees shall develop recommendations on: (1) Optimizing resources; (2) preventing needless redundancies in service; (3) quantitatively evaluating how budgets and financial resources may be shared across thematically similar entities; and (4) leveraging shared resources among entities.
- (c) Each committee shall be composed of 15 members. The general industry regulatory committee shall be composed of members of the entities listed in subsection (f). The public health and welfare regulatory committee shall be composed of members of the entities listed in subsection (g). The financial industry regulatory committee shall be composed of members of the entities listed in subsection (h). No entity shall have more than one member on such committee. The governor shall appoint seven members to each committee. The speaker of the house of representatives and the president of the senate shall each appoint two members to each committee. The minority leader of the house of representatives, the minority leader of the senate, the chairperson of the house committee on appropriations and the chairperson of the senate committee on ways and means shall each appoint one member to each committee. On or after July 1, 2016, and once each year thereafter, each committee shall meet to organize and elect a chairperson, who shall be a legislative appointee and a vice-chairperson, who shall be a governor's appointee.

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(d) No additional compensation, mileage, subsistence or any other pay from state resources may be allowed for service on the committee.

- (e) On or before January 1, 2017, and once each year thereafter, each committee shall develop a written report requesting any executive or legislative action necessary to accomplish the goals established in subsections (a) and (b) and shall send such recommendation to the governor, the president of the senate, the senate minority leader, the speaker of the house of representatives and the house minority leader and the director of legislative research.
- (f) The entities to by studied by the general industry regulatory committee are: The Kansas African affairs commission, state board of agriculture, Kansas agricultural remediation board, Kansas animal health board, Kansas athletic commission, Kansas board of barbering, state building advisory commission, capitol area plaza authority, capitol preservation committee, central Kansas library system, citizens utility ratepayers board, state civil service board, state corporation commission, Kansas state board of cosmetology, Kansas dealer review board, electric transmission authority, Kansas employment first oversight commission, employment security board of review, Kansas state fair board, geographic information systems policy board, governmental ethics commission, human rights commission, Kansas humanities council, state board of indigents' defense services, information network of Kansas, information technology executive council, interagency working group for wind energy, Kansas advisory council on intergovernmental relations, state library of Kansas board, Kansas lottery commission, state board of mortuary arts, northwest Kansas regional library system, partnership historic site committee, pet animal advisory board; postsecondary technical education authority, Kansas propane education and research council, public employees relations board, Kansas racing and gaming commission, Kansas board of regents, advisory committee on regulation of oil and gas activities, Kansas sentencing commission, Kansas sports hall of fame board of trustees, solid waste grants advisory committee, southeast Kansas regional library system, south-central Kansas regional library system, southwest Kansas regional library system, state employee compensation oversight commission, state employee health care commission, state employee pay plan oversight committee, state use law committee, supreme court nominating commission, state board of technical professions, council on travel and tourism, Kansas turnpike authority, state board of veterinary examiners, Washburn university board of regents, Kansas water authority, Wichita state university board of trustees, Kansas wildlife and parks commission, Kansas wind working group, Kansas works state board and the 911 coordinating council.

(h) The entities to by studied by the financial industry regulatory committee are: The abstracters board of examiners, board of accountancy, state banking board, office of the state bank commissioner, Kansas bioscience authority, state board of tax appeals, Kansas credit union council, state department of credit unions, Kansas development finance authority, public finance transparency board, pooled money investment board, real estate appraisal board, Kansas real estate commission, office of the securities commissioner of Kansas and the Kansas public employees' retirement system board of trustees.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
