AN ACT concerning the budget process; implementation of a program 1 2 service inventory, performance based budgeting system and integrated 3 budget fiscal process. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 6 Section 1. (a) On or before January 14, 2019, the department of 7 administration, in consultation with the division of the budget, the office of 8 revisor of statutes and the Kansas legislative research department shall 9 implement a budget process that accomplishes the following objectives: 10 (1) A program service inventory, to be complete on or before January 11 9, 2017. Such inventory shall include, but not be limited to, the following: 12 (A) Identification of agency programs and subprograms by objective, 13 function and purpose; 14 the state or federal statutory citation authorizing those programs, (B) 15 if any: 16 (C) indentification of programs that are mandatory versus 17 discretionary; 18 a history of the programs, including interaction with other agency (D) 19 programs and objectives; 20 state matching or other federal financial requirements; (E) 21 (F) prioritization of the level of all programs and subprograms; and 22 (G) the consequence of not funding the program or subprogram. 23 (2) An integrated budget fiscal process, to be complete on or before 24 January 6, 2018. Such process shall institute common accounting procedures consistent with budget development, budget approval, budget 25 26 submission, through actual expenditures by fund. 27 (3) A performance based budgeting system, to be completed on or 28 before January 14, 2019. Such budgeting system shall include, but not be 29 limited to, the following: 30 (A) Incorporation of various outcome based performance measures, 31 for state programs; and 32 (B) enhancement of the capability to compare program effectiveness 33 across multiple state and political boundaries. 34 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its Sec 2
