SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2091

As Recommended by House Committee on Transportation

Brief*

HB 2091 would remove the requirement that each license plate registration decal issued be numbered serially in each county. The bill instead would require the decal to indicate the license plate number to which the decal is to be affixed.

Background

The bill was requested by the Division of Vehicles, and the Division's Manager of Titles and Registration provided proponent testimony. He stated the current vehicle registration system prints on the decal the number of the license plate to which the decal is to be affixed. There was no other testimony at the House Committee hearing.

The House Committee recommended the bill be placed on the Consent Calendar.

According to the fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget, the Department of Revenue indicates the bill would have no fiscal effect on agency operations, and the Kansas Association of Counties indicates there would be no fiscal effect on local governments.
