

## 2016 Kansas Statutes

**40-1015. Withdrawal of member of company; return premium; cancellation of policy, notice.** Any member of such company may withdraw therefrom by surrendering his policy, together with a notice in writing to the secretary of his intention so to do. Return premium, if any, shall be computed on short-rate basis. The company shall have power to cancel and terminate any policy or any part thereof by mailing a notice of such cancellation and the company's check for the unearned pro rata premium thereon to the insured at the last post-office address furnished by the insured to the company or by delivery of such notice and unearned premium to the insured in person.
