2016 Kansas Statutes

65-6411. Fees. (a) The board may fix the following fees, and any such fees shall be established by rules and regulations adopted by the board:

- (1) For application for licensure as a marriage and family therapist, not to exceed \$150;
- (2) for original licensure as a marriage and family therapist, not to exceed \$175;
- (3) for renewal for licensure as a marriage and family therapist, not to exceed \$175;
- $(4) \quad \text{for application for licensure as a clinical marriage and family therapist, not to exceed \$175;}$
- (5) for original licensure as a clinical marriage and family therapist, not to exceed \$175;
- (6) for renewal for licensure as a clinical marriage and family therapist, not to exceed \$175;
- (7) for reinstatement of a license, not to exceed \$175;
- (8) for replacement of a license, not to exceed \$20;
- (9) for renewal penalty, an amount equal to the renewal of license; and
- (10) for a wallet card license, not to exceed \$5.
- (b) Fees paid to the board are not refundable.
