

## 2016 Kansas Statutes

**84-9-624. Waiver.** (a) **Waiver of disposition notification.** A debtor or secondary obligor may waive the right to notification of disposition of collateral under K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 84-9-611, and amendments thereto, only by an agreement to that effect entered into and authenticated after default.

(b) **Waiver of mandatory disposition.** A debtor may waive the right to require disposition of collateral under K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 84-9-620(e), and amendments thereto, only by an agreement to that effect entered into and authenticated after default.

(c) **Waiver of redemption right.** Except in a consumer-goods transaction, a debtor or secondary obligor may waive the right to redeem collateral under K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 84-9-623, and amendments thereto, only by an agreement to that effect entered into and authenticated after default.
