 - SB 70 passed April 7th last year 124-1 in House, 35-2 in Senate
 - ✓ Removed exemption
 - ✓ Increased insurance limits
 - ✓ Required organization registration, ride permits, inspection certifications, maintenance and training records
 - SB 86 passed June 8th 107-14 House / 33-6 Senate
 - ✓ delayed implementation of penalties/fines until Rules and Reg's adopted

• SB 307 -Passed Senate committee Feb 13th with few amendments; passed Senate Feb 15th 36-0
