Diane Gjerstad (Wichita public schools):

- sub position shouldn't pay into KPERS irrespective of the time subbing b/c district is still paying into KPERS for the regular teacher who is on sick (or other) leave

Hawkins: real question is allowing WAR or not

Trimmer: Dis-incentivizing people from retiring early and use current policies in a way that is detrimental to long-term success of the system. Better to *incentivize* people to stay until age 62

Independent contractors: "daily call" doesn't really apply.
