4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
5	Section 1. K.S.A. 25-101a is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-
6	101a. (a) On the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November in
7	1978, and each four years thereafter, there shall be elected a governor and
8	lieutenant governor running together, a secretary of state, an attorney
9	general, a state treasurer and a state commissioner of insurance.
10	(b) Every candidate for the office of secretary of state, attorney
11	general, state treasurer and state commissioner of insurance shall be a
12	qualified elector of the state of Kansas.
13	(c) Every candidate for the office of governor and lieutenant
14	governor shall be a qualified elector and shall have been a Kansas
15	resident-for at least four-consecutive years prior to becoming such a
16	candidate.
17	{(d) Every candidate for the office of attorney general must be
18	licensed to practice law within the state of Kansas.}
19	Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-101a is hereby repealed.
20	Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force on and after January
21	1, 2019, and its publication in the statute book.
