The American Quarter Horse Association, representing 5,028 members in Kansas, joins the Kansas Quarter Horse Racing Association to express our support of SB 207.

If passed, SB 207 would revive the racing industry in Kansas. The added revenue from SB 207 will provide funding for racetrack operations and lucrative purses, by allowing for a minimum of 400 electronic gaming machines at each racetrack. The income generated will significantly benefit the horse industry as well as the overall economy of Kansas.

As an economically diverse industry, horse owners, industry suppliers, racetracks and off-track betting operations, horse shows and other competitions, recreational riders and other industry segments all generate economic activity contributing to the industry's vibrancy. The spending generated and the subsequent spending between co-dependent industries contributes thousands of jobs and millions of dollars to the Kansas economy on an annual basis. Restoring horse racing in Kansas will stimulate the entire equine community.

The guarantee of live race days and profitable purses will bring horsemen to Kansas. More race days bring more horses, and better purses ensures better horses, all which makes for better racing.
