



**Testimony to the Senate Judiciary Committee
Proponent of HB2571
March 12, 2018**

Chairman Wilborn and Committee Members,

The Kansas Association of Chiefs of Police (KACP) is a proponent of HB2571 in its current form.

The changes made to the proposed bill strikes a reasonable balance between providing access to persons in, or related to, law enforcement video in a defined time (20 business days) and allowing law enforcement time to conduct an investigation into incidents and crimes associated to any video.

I believe there are other portions of the previous versions of both HB2571 and SB360 that need further evaluation and collaborative discussion for potential future changes. This current version of HB2571 begins to move us in a better direction for all the stakeholders.
