Testimony Opposing HB 2205

- I, Addison Lewis, strongly oppose HB 2205, for the following reasons.
 - 1. The Meningococcal vaccine does not cover the most common strain. Serotype B accounts for about 60 percent of these invasive infections and is not vaccine preventable.
 - 2. Meningococcal is not easily transmitted in public settings. Casual contact or breathing the air around an infected person is not how Meningococcal is spread.
 - 3. This is a very rare disease in the state of Kansas and a mandatory vaccine is completely unnecessary.
 - 4. Brain and immune system disorders have been reported after receiving the MCV4 vaccine. The risks outweigh the benefits.
