Subject: HB 2129, Relating to an exception to department of administration energy audit requirements.

This bill permits the Secretary of Administration to waive an energy audit of state-owned property when the secretary determines the audit is not economically feasible. The secretary must also provide the rationale in written form to the joint committee on state building construction whenever that determination is made.

This statute generally requires the Secretary of Administration to adopt rules and regulations for state agencies to conduct regular five-year energy audits. The law was enacted on May 28, 2009.

This bill would take effect upon publication in the statute book.
