SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2269 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2269 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2269 would increase the fee for a certificate of title from \$10 to \$20. The additional \$10 would be directed to a special fund for the county treasurer.

According to the Department of Revenue, there were 1,154,214 titles issued in calendar year 2016. Using this figure, it is estimated that \$11,542,140 would be directed to county treasure special funds starting in FY 2018. The Department would incur additional programming costs of \$5,302 in FY 2018 to update information systems and databases. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2269 is not reflected in *The FY 2018 Governor's Budget Report*.
