SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2317 by Representative Whipple

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2317 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2317 would require employees working on 600 kilovolts or more of electricity or high voltage electrical equipment to receive training or retraining in accordance with Occupational Safety and Health Administration training courses and provisions. The Kansas Department of Labor could adopt rules and regulations to administer provisions of the bill. The Kansas Corporation Commission would be charged with providing assistance to the Department of Labor, as needed.

According to the Department of Labor and the Kansas Corporation Commission, enactment of HB 2317 would have no fiscal effect.
