SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2339 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2339 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2339 would amend current law to exempt from criminal liability individuals in possession of a firearms silencer that was manufactured commercially or privately in the State of Kansas and that has remained within the borders of Kansas. The bill would provide a retroactive date of April 25, 2013.

According to the Office of Judicial Administration, enactment of HB 2339 would have a negligible fiscal effect on the Judicial Branch. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2339 is not reflected in *The FY 2018 Governor's Budget Report*.
