

SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2693 by Representative Tarwater

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2693 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2693 would require the Director of the Budget to prepare and submit to the Legislature a report on federal funds for any budget bill introduced by the Legislature. The report would include a detailed description of each source of federal funds that exceeds \$1.0 million and conditions for continued eligibility for each source of federal funds. For each federal fund, the report would describe the conditions that would be required for continued eligibility. This information would include how the funds would be spent; any related state or local funds that would be used in conjunction with the federal funds, including maintenance of effort requirements; and how the source of federal funds relates to policy matters other than the manner that the funds are spent.

Enactment of HB 2693 would require additional staff time by the Division of the Budget to compile the required information on federal funds. The federal funds information reported by the Division would be gathered through the agency budget submission process, which would require additional staff time by state agencies that receive federal funds. However, any additional costs by state agencies would be negligible.
