SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2707 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2707 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2707 would transfer the registration requirement for charitable organizations soliciting funds within the State of Kansas from the Secretary of State's Office (SOS) to the Office of the Attorney General (OAG). The bill would require all charitable organizations required to register with the state to pay a \$20 registration fee to the OAG. The bill would also transfer all rules and regulations, orders, directives and standards regarding charitable organizations from the SOS to the OAG.

The Office of the Attorney General indicates that enactment of HB 2707 would move where revenues for charitable organization registration fees would be deposited from the Secretary of State's Office to the OAG. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2707 is not reflected in *The FY 2019 Governor's Budget Report*.
