SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 219 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 219 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 219 would eliminate the references to the Secretary of the Department of Corrections (DOC) in statutes pertaining to training required of persons employed by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) as security police officers. The Secretary of DOC would no longer need to specify a basic course of instruction required for employment or verify the completion of such training.

SB 219 is a technical correction bill that would have no fiscal effect on KDADS or the state hospitals.
