SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 240 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 240 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 240 would give the Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism (KDWPT) authority to purchase certain land in Sherman County.

KDWPT indicates the bill would have a fiscal effect but it cannot be estimated. Before purchase, the property would need to be appraised and negotiations would need to take place. The agency indicates that if an agreement is reached, the property would be purchased with a federal grant using 75.0 percent federal dollars and a 25.0 percent state match. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 240 is not reflected in *The FY 2018 Governor's Budget Report*.
