SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 330 by Senate Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 330 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 330 would raise the maximum fee that may be charged by the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism for various permits and licenses, including big game permits, commercial hunting and fishing licenses, fur dealer and furharvester licenses, mussel fishing licenses, wildlife importation permits, turkey tags, and other miscellaneous fees. The bill would also remove statutory requirements regarding permits for commercial guides.

The Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism indicates that SB 330 would have no fiscal effect.
