AN ACT concerning veterans; relating to disabled veteran license plate 1 2 eligibility; amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-160 and repealing the existing section. 3 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 8-160 is hereby amended to read as 6 7 follows: 8-160. As used in this act, the term "disabled veteran" means a 8 person who has served in the armed forces of the United States and who 9 either: (1) Is entitled to compensation for a service-connected disability of at least 50% and the laws administered by the veterans administration or 10 11 who is entitled to compensation for the loss, or permanent loss of use, of 12 one or both feet or one or both hands, or for permanent visual impairment 13 of both eyes to a prescribed degree; or (2) submits satisfactory proof to the 14 director of vehicles pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1,125(a), and amendments thereto, that such person's disability, condition or impairment is 15
