AN ACT concerning immigration; relating to the Kansas highway patrol; authorizing a memorandum of agreement for the enforcement of immigration laws.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The superintendent of the Kansas highway patrol shall seek to negotiate terms and conditions of a memorandum of agreement between the state of Kansas and the United States department of homeland security, as provided in 8 U.S.C. § 1357(g), concerning the enforcement of federal immigration laws, detentions and removals, and related investigations in this state by certain officers of the Kansas highway patrol designated by the superintendent.

- (b) Any memorandum of agreement negotiated pursuant to subsection (a) shall be signed on behalf of the state of Kansas by the superintendent of the Kansas highway patrol, or as otherwise required by the United States department of homeland security.
- (c) On or before January 1, 2018, the superintendent of the Kansas highway patrol shall submit a report to the governor and the legislature on the status of the superintendent's attempts to enter into the memorandum of agreement described in subsection (a).
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
