AN ACT concerning administrative rules and regulations; joint committee
 on administrative rules and regulations; state rules and regulations
 board; membership; amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 77-423 and 77-436
 and repealing the existing sections.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 77-423 is hereby amended to read as Section 1. 8 follows: 77-423. There is hereby created a state rules and regulations board 9 consisting of the attorney general or the attorney general's designee, the 10 secretary of state or the secretary of state's designee, the secretary of administration or the secretary of administration's designee, the 11 12 chairperson of the joint committee on administrative rules and regulations 13 or a member of the joint committee designated by the chairperson from the 14 same house of the legislature as the chairperson-and, the vice-chairperson 15 of the joint committee on administrative rules and regulations or a member 16 of the joint committee designated by the vice-chairperson from the same house of the legislature as the vice-chairperson, and the ranking minority 17 18 member of the joint committee on administrative rules and regulations or 19 a member of the joint committee designated by the minority leader of the 20 same house of the legislature as the chairperson. If a member is 21 designated to serve on the board by the chairperson or vice-chairperson of 22 the joint committee, the designated member shall serve in lieu of the 23 designating officer on a temporary or permanent basis as specified by the 24 designating officer. The attorney general shall be the chairperson of the 25 board. The secretary of state shall serve as the secretary to the board. The 26 state rules and regulations board shall determine whether a rule and 27 regulation should be adopted as a temporary rule and regulation, shall 28 determine the rules and regulations to be published in the Kansas 29 administrative regulations and in the annual supplement to such 30 regulations as provided for in this act and shall perform such other duties 31 as may be required by this act.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 77-436 is hereby amended to read as follows: 77-436. (a) There is hereby established a joint committee on administrative rules and regulations which shall consist of five senators and seven members of the house of representatives. The five senator members shall be appointed as follows: Three by the committee on

1 organization, calendar and rules and two by the minority leader of the 2 senate. The seven representative members shall be appointed as follows: 3 Four by the speaker of the house of representatives and three by the 4 minority leader of the house of representatives. The committee on 5 organization, calendar and rules shall designate a senator member to be 6 chairperson or vice-chairperson of the joint committee as provided in this 7 section. The speaker of the house of representatives shall designate a 8 representative member to be chairperson or vice-chairperson of the joint 9 committee as provided in this section. The minority leader of the senate 10 shall designate a senator member to be the ranking minority member of the joint committee as provided in this section. The minority leader of the 11 12 house of representatives shall designate a representative member to be the ranking minority member of the joint committee as provided in this 13 14 section

15 (b) A quorum of the joint committee on administrative rules and regulations shall be seven. All actions of the committee may be taken by a 16 17 majority of those present when there is a quorum. In odd-numbered years 18 the chairperson and the ranking minority member of the joint committee 19 shall be the designated member *members* of the house of representatives 20 from the convening of the regular session in that year until the convening 21 of the regular session in the next ensuing year. In even-numbered years the 22 chairperson and the ranking minority member of the joint committee shall 23 be the designated member members of the senate from the convening of 24 the regular session of that year until the convening of the regular session of 25 the next ensuing year. The vice-chairperson shall exercise all of the powers of the chairperson in the absence of the chairperson. 26

(c) All proposed rules and regulations shall be reviewed by the joint
committee on administrative rules and regulations during the public
comment period required by K.S.A. 77-421, and amendments thereto. The
committee may introduce such legislation as it deems necessary in
performing its functions of reviewing administrative rules and regulations.

(d) All rules and regulations filed each year in the office of secretary
of state shall be subject to review by the joint committee. The committee
may introduce such legislation as it deems necessary in performing its
functions of reviewing administrative rules and regulations.

36 (e) The joint committee shall meet on call of the chairperson as 37 authorized by the legislative coordinating council. All such meetings shall 38 be held in Topeka, unless authorized to be held in a different place by the 39 legislative coordinating council. Members of the joint committee shall 40 receive compensation and travel expenses and subsistence expenses or 41 allowances as provided in K.S.A. 75-3212, and amendments thereto, when attending meetings of such committee authorized by the legislative 42 43 coordinating council.

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(f) Amounts paid under authority of this section shall be paid from 1 appropriations for legislative expense and vouchers therefor shall be 2 prepared by the director of legislative administrative services and approved by the chairperson or vice-chairperson of the legislative 3 4 coordinating council. 5

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Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 77-423 and 77-436 are hereby repealed. Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 7 8 publication in the statute book.
