## HOUSE BILL No. 2316

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AN ACT concerning the minimum wage; enacting the Kansas working 1 2 families pay raise act; amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 44-1203 and 3 repealing the existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 44-1203 is hereby amended to read as 6 7 follows: 44-1203. (a) Except as otherwise provided in the minimum wage 8 and maximum hours law, every employer shall pay to each employee 9 wages at a rate as follows: 10 (1) Prior to January 1, 2010, employee wages shall be paid at a rate of 11 not less than \$2.65 an hour; and 12 (2) on and after January 1, 2010, and prior to January 1, 2018, 13 employee wages shall be paid at a rate of not less than \$7.25 an hour; 14 (3) on and after January 1, 2018, and prior to January 1, 2019, employee wages shall be paid at a rate of not less than \$9.84 an hour; 15 (4) on and after January 1, 2019, and prior to January 1, 2020, 16 employee wages shall be paid at a rate of not less than \$12.42 an hour; 17 18 and 19 (5) on and after January 1, 2020, employee wages shall be paid at a 20 rate of not less than \$15.00 an hour. (b) In calculating such minimum wage rate, an employer may include 21 22 tips and gratuities received by an employee if such tips and gratuities have 23 customarily constituted part of the remuneration of the employee and if the 24 employee concerned actually received and retained such tips and 25 gratuities. For employees receiving tips and gratuities, the employer shall 26 pay a minimum wage of at least \$2.13 an hour prior to January 1, 2018; 27 at least \$2.48 an hour on and after January 1, 2018, and prior to January 28 1, 2019; at least \$2.78 an hour on and after January 1, 2019, and prior to 29 January 1, 2020; and at least \$3.08 an hour on and after January 1, 2020. 30 If when combined with the minimum wage rate prescribed in this 31 subsection the amount of the employee's tips and gratuities are: 32 (1) At least equal to \$7.25 an hour the minimum wage rate per hour

*prescribed by subsection (a)*, no further payment is required by the employer; or

(2) less than \$7.25 an hour the minimum wage rate per hour
prescribed by subsection (a), the employer must pay the employee the

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difference between \$7.25 an hour the minimum wage rate per hour
prescribed by subsection (a) and the actual hourly amount received by the
employee determined by combining the amount of tips and gratuities
received by the employee with the minimum wage prescribed by this
subsection paid by the employer.

6 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any employers 7 and employees who are covered under the provisions of the federal fair 8 labor standards act-(, 29 U.S.C.A. § 201 et seq.), and any other acts-9 amendatory thereof or supplemental *amendments* thereto.

- 10 *(d)* The 2017 amendments to this section shall be known as the 11 Kansas working families pay raise act.
- 12 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 44-1203 is hereby repealed.
- 13 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force on and after January
- 14 1, 2018, and its publication in the statute book.
