AN ACT concerning rural opportunity zones; amending K.S.A. 2016 1 2 Supp. 74-50,222 and repealing the existing section. 3 4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 74-50,222 is hereby amended to read as 5 follows: 74-50,222.
