Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 74-50,222 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-50,222. As used in K.S.A. 74-50,222, 74-50,223 and 79-32,267, and amendments thereto:

- (a) "Institution of higher education" means a public or private nonprofit educational institution that meets the requirements of participation in programs under the higher education act of 1965, as amended, 34 C.F.R. § 600;

 - (c) "secretary" means the secretary of commerce; and
- 24 (d) "student loan" means a federal student loan program supported by 25 the federal government and a nonfederal loan issued by a lender such as a 26 bank, savings and loan or credit union to help students and parents pay 27 school expenses for attendance at an institution of higher education.
