1 AN ACT concerning telecommunications; relating to broadband 2 development; concerning income tax credits.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) Any taxpayer that holds certificated telephone service 6 territory in a rural area that is unable or unwilling to provide broadband 7 service to customers in such rural area may elect to release those customers through the filing of a change of study area with the state 8 corporation commission. Any taxpayer that makes such an election shall 9 10 be entitled to a deduction from Kansas adjusted gross income in an amount 11 equal to the amount of the value of the existing customers. The valuation 12 of such deduction shall be the sum of the net cash flow of each customer to 13 the company for the previous five years within the service territory in question and the state assessed value of the infrastructure serving those 14 customers. The taxpaver may take 20% of the value, as determined above 15 for five consecutive years, after the federal communications commission 16 approves the change of study area application forwarded by the 17 18 commission.

(b) To ensure that the existing customers of the local exchange carrier
or electing carrier continue to be served, the local exchange carrier or
electing carrier shall negotiate with the provider of broadband service that
is willing to meet the performance requirements to continue serving the
existing customers as the necessary infrastructure is installed.

(c) (1) "Broadband service" means a retail service that utilizes
infrastructure with the capacity to transmit data to enable a subscriber to
the service to originate and receive high-quality voice, data, graphics and
video, without regard to delivery technology and that:

(A) Is capable of minimum download speeds of at least 25 megabits
 per second and minimum upload speeds of at least three megabits per
 second;

31 (B) provides an average latency of less than 100 milliseconds to 32 enable the use of real-time communications; and

(C) provides subscribers with a minimum monthly data allowance of
 150 gigabytes per month.

(2) "Rural area" means a county with an average population densityof less than 100 persons per square mile, excluding the county seat, and

- that is either:
- (A) Not served by any broadband service provider; or
  (B) served by a broadband service provider, but less than 10% of the persons in such county have access to broadband service.
