[^0]:    AN ACT concerning certain statewide elected officials; amending K.S.A. 25-101a and repealing the existing section.

    Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
    Section 1. K.S.A. 25-101a is hereby amended to read as follows: 25101a. (a) On the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November in 1978, and each four years thereafter, there shall be elected a governor and lieutenant governor running together, a secretary of state, an attorney general, a state treasurer and a state commissioner of insurance.
    (b) Every candidate for the office of secretary of state, attorney general, state treasurer and state commissioner of insurance shall be a qualified elector of the state of Kansas.
    (c) Every candidate for the office of governor and lieutenant governor shall be a qualified elector-and shall have been a Kansasresident for at least fout consective years prior to beeoming such aeandidate.
    \{(d) Every candidate for the office of attorney general must be licensed to practice law within the state of Kansas.\}

    Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-101a is hereby repealed.
    Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force on and after January 1,2019 , and its publication in the statute book.
