AN ACT concerning elections; dealing with voter registration.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The secretary of state shall develop a voter registration program to offer voter registration services through the following agencies:

- (1) The department for children and families;
- (2) the department for aging and disability services; and
- (3) the county register of deeds office.
- (b) At the time of making an application for assistance or benefits with the department for children and families or the department for aging and disability services the applicant shall be offered the opportunity to register to vote. Any individual who files a property deed with a county register of deeds shall be offered the opportunity to register to vote.
- (c) If proof of citizenship was not required for the service applied for, or the person is filing a property deed with a county register of deeds, the applicant or the person filing the property deed shall be informed that proof of citizenship will be necessary to complete the process of registering to vote.
- (d) Voter registration applications shall be submitted to the secretary of state and the county election officers as provided by rules and regulations adopted by the secretary of state.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
