AN ACT concerning state finance; relating to budget bills introduced by the legislature and the governor's budget report; requiring preparation of a federal moneys report by the director of the budget.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section:

- (1) "Budget bill" means any bill that appropriates moneys for one or more state agencies.
- (2) "Federal moneys" includes any federal grants in aid or other federal moneys that are included in any budget bill or any governor's budget report.
- (b) The director of the budget shall prepare and submit to the legislature a federal moneys report for any budget bill introduced by the legislature or any governor's budget report that is published on or after the effective date of this section. The federal moneys report shall include a detailed description of:
- (1) Each source of federal moneys that exceeds \$1,000,000 in the aggregate; and
- (2) conditions that shall be met for continued eligibility for each such source of federal moneys, based on relevant federal law, regulation and guidance, clearly separated into the following three categories of conditions that:
 - (A) Describe the manner in which federal moneys shall be spent;
- (B) describe the manner in which any related state or local moneys shall be spent, including maintenance of effort or similar requirements; and
- (C) relate to policy matters other than the manner in which federal, state or local moneys shall be spent.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
