1 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending
2 June 30, 2018, and June 30, 2019, for the judicial branch.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2018, and June 30,
6 2019, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are
7 hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees,
8 receipts, disbursements, procedures and acts incidental to the foregoing are
9 hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

10 (b) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 75-
11 6702(a), and amendments thereto.

12 (c) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the
13 provisions of K.S.A. 46-155, and amendments thereto.

15 JUDICIAL BRANCH

16 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general
17 fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the following:

19 *Provided*, That any unencumbered balance in the judiciary operations
20 account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2017, is hereby reappropriated for
21 fiscal year 2018: *Provided further*, That contracts for computer input of
22 judicial opinions and all purchases thereunder shall not be subject to the
23 provisions of K.S.A. 75-3739, and amendments thereto: *And provided*
24 *further*, That expenditures may be made from the judiciary operations
25 account for contingencies without limitation at the discretion of the chief
26 justice: *And provided further*, That expenditures from the judiciary
27 operations account for such contingencies shall not exceed \$25,000: *And*
28 *provided further*, That expenditures from the judiciary operations account
29 for official hospitality shall not exceed \$4,000: *And provided further*, That
30 expenditures shall be made from the judiciary operations account for the
31 travel expenses of panels of the court of appeals for travel to cities across
32 the state to hear appealed cases.

33 (b) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following
34 special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, all
35 moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund or
36 funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law shall

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(a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, the following:

Judiciary operations (677-00-1000-0103).....\$122,330,763

Provided, That any unencumbered balance in the judiciary operations account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2018, is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2019: *Provided further*, That contracts for computer input of judicial opinions and all purchases thereunder shall not be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 75-3739, and amendments thereto: *And provided further*, That expenditures may be made from the judiciary operations account for contingencies without limitation at the discretion of the chief justice: *And provided further*, That expenditures from the judiciary operations account for such contingencies shall not exceed \$25,000: *And provided further*, That expenditures from the judiciary operations account for official hospitality shall not exceed \$4,000: *And provided further*, That expenditures shall be made from the judiciary operations account for the travel expenses of panels of the court of appeals for travel to cities across the state to hear appealed cases.

(b) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, all moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund or funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law shall not exceed the following:

Provided, That expenditures may be made from the judicial branch education fund to provide services and programs for the purpose of educating and training judicial branch officers and employees, administering the training, testing and education of municipal judges as provided in K.S.A. 12-4114, and amendments thereto, educating and training municipal judges and municipal court support staff, and for the planning and implementation of a family court system, as provided by law, including official hospitality: *Provided further*, That the judicial administrator is hereby authorized to fix, charge and collect fees for such services and programs: *And provided further*, That such fees may be fixed to cover all or part of the operating expenditures incurred in providing such services and programs, including official hospitality: *And provided further*, That all fees received for such services and programs, including official hospitality, shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the judicial branch education fund.

23 Sec. 4. If any fund or account name described by words and the
 24 numerical accounting code that follows such fund or account name do not
 25 match, it shall be conclusively presumed that the legislature intended that
 26 the fund or account name described by words is the correct fund or
 27 account name, and such fund or account name described by words shall
 28 control over a contradictory or incorrect numerical accounting code.

29 Sec. 5. *Severability*. If any provision or clause of this act or
 30 application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such
 31 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which
 32 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
 33 end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

34 Sec. 6. *Appeals to exceed expenditure limitations*. (a) Upon written
 35 application to the governor and approval of the state finance council,
 36 expenditures from special revenue funds may exceed the amounts
 37 specified in this act.

38 (b) This section shall not apply to the expanded lottery act revenues
 39 fund, state economic development initiatives fund, the children's initiatives
 40 fund, the state water plan fund or the Kansas endowment for youth fund,
 41 or to any account of any of such funds.

42 Sec. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
 43 publication in the statute book.
