Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 76-12a17 is hereby amended to read as 8 follows: 76-12a17. No person employed by the secretary for aging and disability services shall receive a permanent appointment as a security 9 10 police officer as authorized by K.S.A. 76-12a16, and amendments thereto, 11 unless such person has been awarded a certificate by the secretary-of 12 eorrections for aging and disability services attesting to such person's 13 satisfactory completion of a basic course of instruction specified by the 14 secretary for aging and disability services and the secretary of corrections. Such certificate shall be awarded only following verification of completion 15 16 of the training provided by both departments the Kansas department for aging and disability services. Such certificate shall be effective during the 17 18 term of a person's employment, except that any person who has terminated 19 employment with the secretary for aging and disability services for a 20 period exceeding one year shall be required to be certified again.
