AN ACT concerning appraisal of real property before purchase or disposal by the state or any agency thereof; relating to duties of the judicial administrator and the director of property valuation; amending K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 75-3043a and repealing the existing section.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 75-3043a is hereby amended to read as 8 follows: 75-3043a. Except as otherwise specifically provided by statute or 9 rule and regulation, prior to the state of Kansas or any agency thereof purchasing or disposing of any real property, by deed, mortgage, gift or 10 11 other means of conveyance, transfer or exchange, such property shall be 12 appraised by one disinterested appraiser, to be appointed by the judicial administrator director of property valuation, to determine the market-value 13 14 appraisal of such property; but. Nothing in this section shall be construed as establishing or limiting the consideration for the acquisition or 15 16 disposition of any such property. If the value of the real property is over \$200,000 as determined by the county assessment value of such property, 17 the judicial administrator director of property valuation may appoint three 18 19 disinterested appraisers to determine the market-value appraisal of such 20 real property. Any appraiser selected pursuant to this section shall receive 21 reasonable fees or compensation from legislative appropriations made 22 available therefor.
