Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 72-296 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-296. (a) The state department of education shall conduct a study of the cost of career technical education programs offered by school districts, including, but not limited to, the following:

- (1) The career technical education programs offered by school districts;
- (2) the costs associated with offering such programs, including salaries and wages, materials, equipment and facilities; and
  - (3) the coordination between school districts, community colleges and technical colleges in offering such programs.
  - (b) On or before January 15,—2018 2019, the state department of education shall prepare a report on its findings and shall make recommendations on amendments to the Kansas school equity and enhancement act, K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 72-5131 et seq., and amendments thereto, for the financing of career technical education programs using a tiered technical education model or other funding model. The report shall be submitted to the governor and the legislature.
- 23 (c) The provisions of this section shall expire on July 1, <del>2018</del> 2019.
- 24 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 72-296 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
