AN ACT concerning the legislature; relating to bills introduced by committees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) For any bill approved for introduction and sponsored by any standing committee of either house of the legislature, the committee chairperson shall keep or have the committee secretary keep minutes of meetings that include the legislator or other person, state or local agency, organization or entity that requested the bill for introduction by the committee.

(b) Any person or organization may request the introduction of legislation by any standing committee of either house of the legislature.

 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
