### **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 461**

# As Recommended by Senate Committee of the Whole

## **Brief\***

SB 461 would reconcile amendments to statutes that were amended more than once during the current and prior legislative sessions. For such statutes, the bill would repeal one version and amend the continuing version with non-contradictory amendments from the repealed version, creating a single version of the statute containing all amendments.

# **Background**

The bill was introduced by the Senate Committee on Ways and Means. The Office of Revisor of Statutes submits a bill of this type annually to reconcile conflicting statutes. The bill was originally referred to the Senate Committee on Ways and Means and then was withdrawn and referred to the Senate Committee of the Whole.

No fiscal note was available when the bill was considered by the Senate Committee of the Whole.
